




Key Stage 1 Information for Parents/Carers

Home-School Communication

Please do not feel that homework books or reading records replace face-to-face discussions with staff. Please do not hesitate to contact us by telephone or at pick-up time if you need anything.

Please keep reading with your child and make a note in their reading records the page numbers they've read to and when they have finished the book. We recommend 10-15 minutes every day. In year 2, we do guided reading sessions as well as individual reading with adults.



As a school we are focusing on **RESILIENCE**. We always support pupils but will be encouraging them to take responsibility for their own actions and learn from things that they find challenging. Staff will support through lots of praise and encouragement.

In KS1, your child will receive homework every Friday to be handed back in as early as possible the following week. This will be one piece relating to work covered in class during that week. In addition, for Year 2, there may be times when specific English and Maths activities will be given for an extra boost.

We have recommended that KS1 children do not bring their own belongings like pencil cases, toys and key-rings as they can get broken or lost.

Your child's target ladders will be in their homework books. Please sign to let the teacher know that you have seen them.

Just a reminder that everything should be labelled with children's names. We have large buckets in every classroom for children's belongings.
