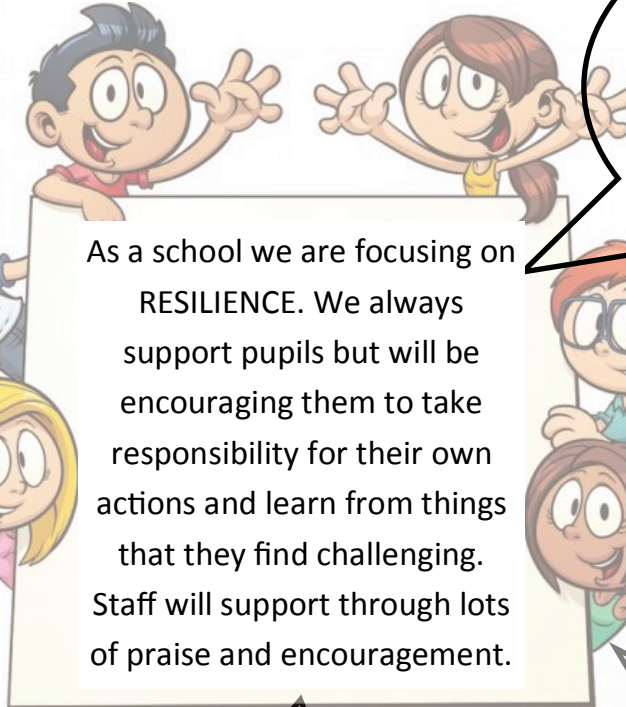




## Key Stage 2 Information for Parents/Carers

### Home-School Communication



As a school we are focusing on **RESILIENCE**. We always support pupils but will be encouraging them to take responsibility for their own actions and learn from things that they find challenging. Staff will support through lots of praise and encouragement.

Please do not feel that homework diaries replace face-to-face discussions with staff. Please do not hesitate to contact us by telephone or at pick-up time if you need anything.

Please keep reading with your child. Ask them questions about the characters, vocabulary, plot or punctuation used. The pupils will be rewarded each time they have read at home and this has been recorded.

Encourage your child to start taking responsibility for their belongings; homework, letters, dinner money etc. Support them in recording in their diary to remind them what they need to give to the class teacher/bring home each day.

Please use your child's homework diary to record when you have read with your child and sign it each weekend.

Your child's target ladders will be in their homework work books. Please sign to let the teacher know that you have seen them.

Use the comments section to record any messages to your child's class teacher about homework, reading or letters.

Encourage your child to show you their homework diary on a daily basis—there may be messages from the class teacher or reminders.
