English	Write a letter from someone living in one of the Extreme Environments we are learning about explaining about what the place they live in is like.	Research any African country (not Kenya) and create a fact file on it with lots of information and photographs.	Research a famous person from Africa or the Polar regions and create a hyperlinked PowerPoint about them.
Maths	Choose ten African countries, find out their populations and then round them to the nearest ten million, the nearest million and the nearest hundred thousand.	Make a graph to show the populations of ten African countries (rounded to the nearest millions).	Find the populations of three African capital cities, three European capital cities and three Asian capital cities and write them in order from least to greatest.
Creative and Computing	Construct a model igloo using any resources or media you want.	Make a collage or a painting of an African/Polar landscape or an African polar animal.	Construct a small vehicle which could be used to cross icy terrains (you could use Lego, Meccano, kits?).
	Find out what an inukshuk is and make one.	Use a QR codes website to create a game using facts about a polar region or African country.	Create a computer game using a Programming website such as Scratch based on either a polar region or an African country.
